WHAT IS R.S.V.P.?

RSVP is a non-denominational support group for the divorced, widowed and separated.

WHY IS RSVP IMPORTANT?

It is very important! Life patterns change and the process of adjustment can be very difficult if one has to go through it alone, The trauma, pain, and agony that accompany a loss can be made bearable and the grief process worked through more effectively with the assistance of others who have had a common experience.

WHO MAY PARTICIPATE?

This program is intended for person whose marriages have ended.

- Divorce
- Widowed
- Separated

WHAT TAKES PLACE AT A RSVP PROGRAM?

Consist of presentations by a trained team of divorce/widowed men and women followed by personal private reflection and dialogue in small groups. Groups are bilingual (english/spanish).

WHEN AND WHERE ARE THE PROGRAM?


RSVP program meets once a week for 10 successive weeks on Tuesdays from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. at Cameron Retreat Center at St. Dominic Archdiocesan Center, 2401 Holcombe Blvd. Houston.
